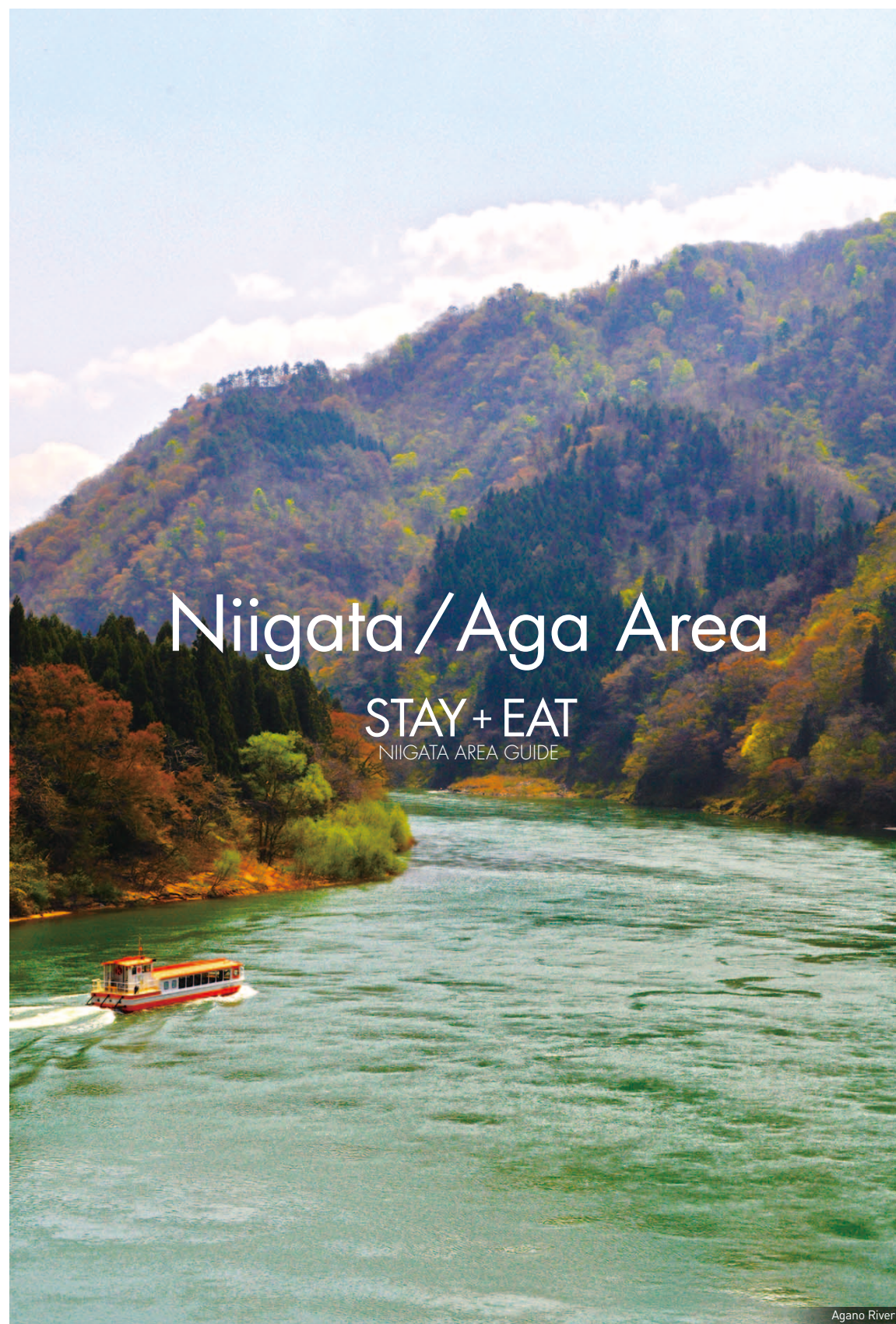

Geisha

A rich treasure house of food was created from the two major rivers of Agano and Shinano. The area is alive with this distinctive food culture which includes geisha culture and fermentation culture.

Japan's longest river, the Shinano, flows into the Sea of Japan in Niigata City. The city, whose ports open out into the sea, has had marine routes for a very long time and from trade and cultural exchange, ryotei culture and fermentation culture and other phenomena have developed together to form a distinctive food culture. The geisha quarters which were patronized by visitors to the port towns are still going strong today, so that geisha can still be seen in the elegant townscapes, and the atmosphere of these old towns can be felt. Along the Agano River, swans in large numbers come over in the winter to create a wide and beautiful scene surrounded by plentiful villages and deep mountains. This area, where a variety of seasonal flowers bloom, also has its share of unique natural hot springs. Soaking in these onsen in the middle of Mother Nature and dining on the local dishes blessed from the mountains and rivers will bring relaxation to body and soul away from the busy everyday.

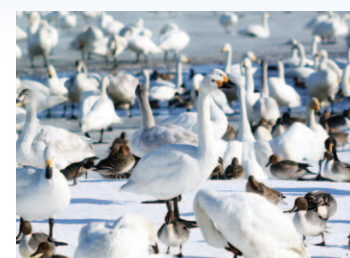

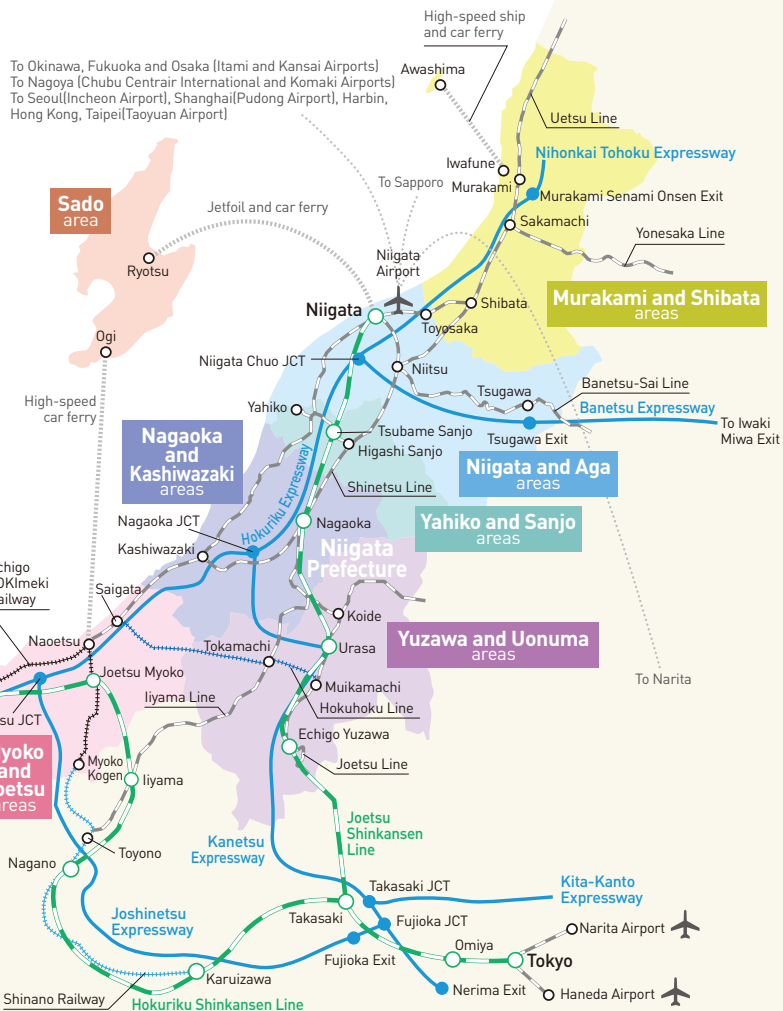
